

Scoreboard Carrier

Volunteer Role

Dates Required: Wednesday 15 July 2026 - Sunday 19 July 2026

The Scoreboard Carrier role will involve carrying and updating the manual scoreboard for the game you are assigned to, providing spectators with information on each players and respective live scores to par.

Roles & Responsibilities

The role of a Scoreboard Carrier will be to manually update the score in the game you are assigned to. Scoreboard Carriers can be expected to carry out the following duties:

- Prepare the manual scoreboard prior to the round you are scheduled to work, ahead of carrying a manual scoreboard around the 18 holes per day you are allocated.
- Liaising with the Walking Scorer and Referee to keep players scores up to date on the carry board for the benefit of spectators.

Experience

- Interest/understanding in golf is essential.
- Golf/general event experience would be beneficial.

Skills

- The role requires individuals to be on their feet for 18 holes, averaging about 6 hours per day. You are required to carry the board for 18 holes per day.
- Self-motivated and proactive.
- Good communication skills.
- A knowledge of golf or The Open is desirable but not essential.
